- (a) Stonehaugh, ruins, 40 by 24 ft., walls 4½ft. thick (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. ix, 216; Curwen, *Castles*, 397).
- (b) Stonegarthside Hall, old house of the Forsters (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. ix, 217).

Old road (?):

(a) At Stonygate, ¹/₄m. N.N.E. of the church.
