










Mapping medieval settlement deficits - North Stanmore

-  - township commons

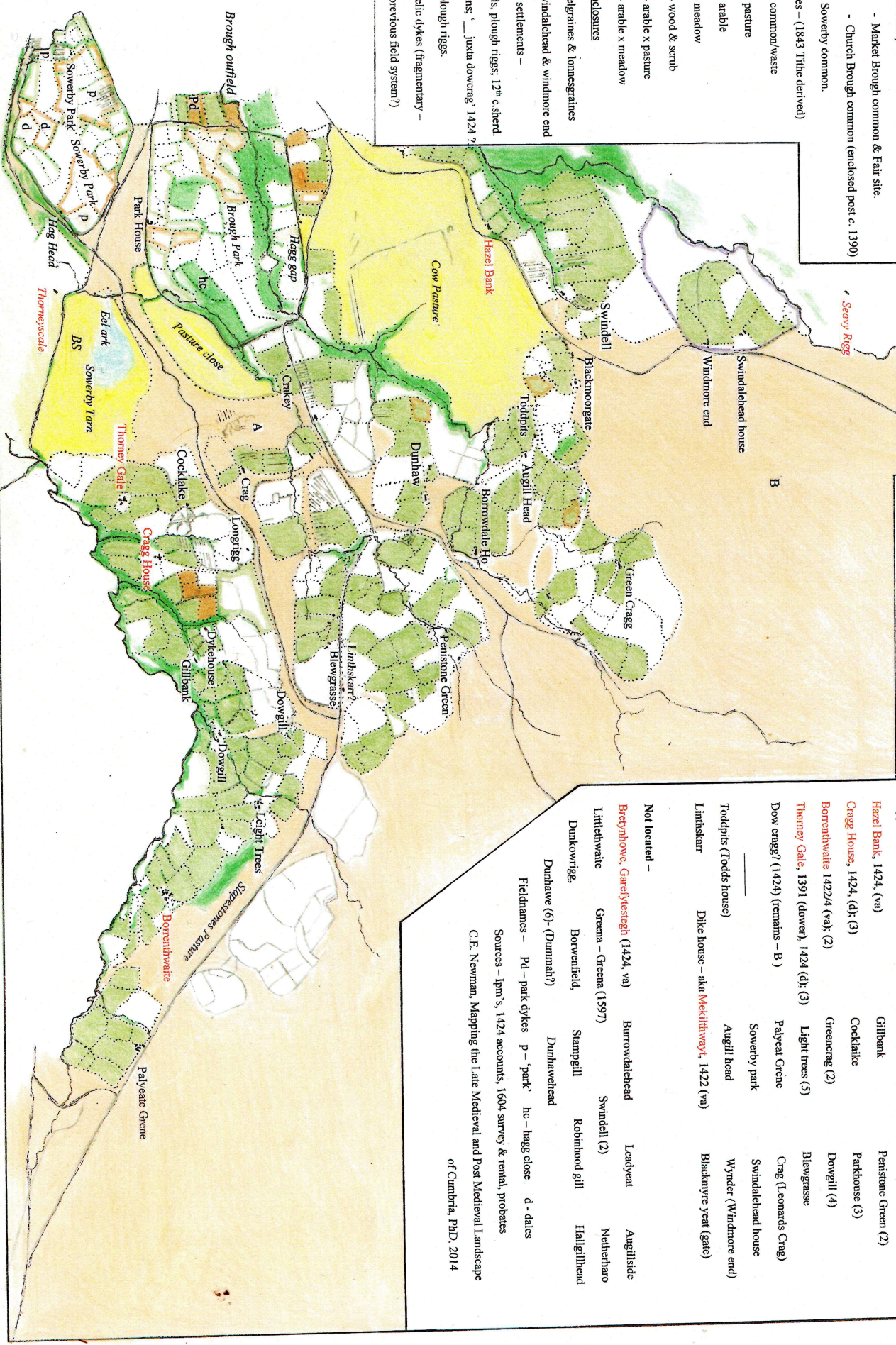
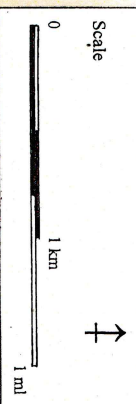
- Cow pasture** - Market Brough common & Fair site.
- Pasture close** - Church Brough common (enclosed post c. 1390)
- BS** - Brough Sowerby common.

Estimated uses - (1843 Tithe derived)

-  - common/waste
-  - pasture

-  - wood & scrub
-  - arable x pasture
-  - arable x meadow

Inclousures

-  - swindlegates & lornegraines (pre 1291); swindalehead & windmore end
- Deserted settlements -
- A - huts, fields, plough riggs; 12th c. sherd.
- B - foundations; '...juxta dowrge' 1424?
-  - plough riggs.
-  - relic dykes (fragmentary - previous field system?)
